## What ecosystem services do you have in and around your living area?

I'm currently living in Quezon City which is considered to be a highly-urbanized city in the Philippines. Having said, it will be hard to identify the ecosystem present in this area. Hence, I will share the different ecosystem in Bulacan City which is a sub-urban city neighboring the city I live in.

### **Provisioning services**

Food and Fresh Water are ecosystem services that is available in the area for local use.
